PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68747 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to John R. Mc Eachern and Gloria Utley of Goldmohr Terrace, PO Box 1071, Lakeview, Oregon 97630, phone 947-3010, for the use of the waters of an unnamed stream, a tributary of Drews Creek, for the PURPOSE of Domestic use,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from June 5, 1986,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 3.0 gallons per minute.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 35.5 feet South and 105 feet East from the Northwest corner of Section 5, being within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 5, Township 40 South, Range 18 East, WM, in the County of Lake.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
Township 40 South, Range 18 East, WM Section 6 NE1/4 NE1/4 Domestic

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 18, 1988, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 89.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 90.
