## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68999 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Robert B. Harward of 6300 Cahuenga Blvd, N. Hollywood, California 91606, phone (818) 766-7926, for the use of the waters of Noname Creek, a tributary of North Fork Santiam River, for the PURPOSE of Livestock water and irrigation of 5.0 acres; being 0.005 cubic foot per second for livestock water and 0.063 cfs for irrigation,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from January 21, 1987 for 0.03 cfs and January 27, 1987 for 0.038 cfs,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.068 cubic foot per second.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 150 feet South and 1800 feet West from the Northeast corner of Section 18, being within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 18, Township 9 South, Range 2 East, WM, in the County of Marion.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 9 South, Range 2 East, WM	Section 7 SW1/4 SE1/4	2.7 acres & stock
	Section 18 NW1/4 NE1/4	2.3 acres & stock

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to  $\frac{1}{80}$  of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 18, 1988, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 89 .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 90 .
