PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 69010 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Franklin D. Dryden of 1535 Arroyo View Drive, Pasadena, California 91103, phone (818) 795-4797, for the use of the waters of Applegate River and Applegate Lake Reservoir constructed under Permit R-7810, for the PURPOSE of Irrigation of 1.8 acres,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from February 4, 1987,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1030 feet South and 1120 feet East from the Northwest corner, being within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 25, Township 38 South, Range 4 West, WM, in the County of Jackson. (Applegate Reservoir Dam - S1/2 SE 1/4, of Section 25, Township 40 South, Range 4 West, WM)

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 38 South, Range 4 West, WM Section 25 NW1/4 NW1/4 1.3 acres NE1/4 NW1/4 0.5 acre

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from Applegate Lake Reservoir constructed under Permit R-7810, and is subject to the terms and conditions of Contract 7-07-10-W0677 between the Bureau of Reclamation and the applicant, or a satisfactory replacement, a copy of which is on file in the records of the Water Resources Director, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 90 .
