PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 69019 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Kesterson Bros. Logging Company, an Oregon Corporation, of 20028 Hwy. 138 W., Oakland, Oregon 97462, phone 584-2280, for the use of the waters of Umpqua River, a tributary of Pacific Ocean, for the PURPOSE of Irrigation of 194.0 acres,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from February 23, 1987,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 2.4 cubic feet per second.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: #1 - 1280 feet South and 2440 feet West from the corner of Sections 10, 11, 14, and 15, being within Lot 2 (NW 1/4 NE 1/4), Section 15; #2 - 60 feet North and 120 feet East from the one quarter corner of Sections 10 and 11, being within Lot 1 (SW 1/4 NW 1/4), Section 11; #3 465 feet North and 3760 feet West from the one quarter corner of Section 10 and 11, being*

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

* within Lot 1 (SE 1/4 NW 1/4), Section 10, all in Township 23 South, Range 7 West, WM, in the County of Douglas.

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 18, 1988, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 89.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 90.
