## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 69095 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Elvin D. and Linda L. Rhoads of 21800 SW Finnigan Hill Road, Hillsboro, Oregon 97123, phone 538-6059, for the use of the waters of Spring #1 when available with any deficiency in the available supply from Spring #1 to be\* for the PURPOSE of Domestic use including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from May 13, 1987,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Spring #1 - 450 feet North and 270 feet West, Spring #2 - 150 feet North and 460 feet West both from the Southeast corner of Section 23, both being within the SE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 23, Township 2 South, Range 3 West, WM, in the County of Yamhill.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 2 South, Range 3 West, WM Section 23 SE1/4 SE1/4 Domestic use including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and non-commercial garden

\* made up by appropriation from Spring #2,

This right is further limited during the period July 31 through September 15 of each year to human consumption and livestock consumption for such animals as are essential to the proper sustenance of the family,

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 18, 1988, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1989. *extended to 10-1-90* Extended to October 1, 1991, 10-1-92

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1990. Extended to October 1, 1991, 10-1-92
