PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION ⁶⁹¹⁷⁶ and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Iseli Nursery of 30590 SE Kelso Road, Boring, Oregon 97009, phone 863-3822, for the use of stored water only from Reservoir 4 to be constructed under Application R-69175, Permit R-10837, a tributary of Tickle Creek, for the PURPOSE of Containerized Nursery stock

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from June 30, 1987,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 109.0 acre-feet annually

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 2300 feet North and 1320 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 8, being within the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 8, Township 2 South, Range 4 East, WM, in the County of Clackamas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 19, 1988, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1989.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1990.
