PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **66838** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **Malheur National Forest of 139 Northeast Dayton St., John Day, Oregon 97845, phone 575-1731, for the use of the waters of an unnamed tributary of Hawkins Creek (SL-22 site) and Hawkins Creek (SL-26),** for the PURPOSE of **livestock**

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **September 26, 1983**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **0.02 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 cfs from each diversion**

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: **SL-22: 2300 feet North and 2600 feet West from the Southeast corner of Section 5, being within the NW1/4 SE1/4 of Section 5; SL-26: 400 feet South and 2500 feet East from the Northwest corner of Section 9, being within the NE1/4 NW1/4 of Section 9, both being within Township 10 South, Range 32 East, W.M. in the County of Grant.**

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 10 South, Range 32 East, W.M. Section 5	NW1/4 SE1/4	Livestock
	Section 9 NE1/4 NW1/4	

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **October 20, 1988**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 **89**.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 **90**.
