PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68644 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Pine Hollow Cooperative, Inc. of Route 1, Box 27, Tygh Valley, Oregon 97063, phone 544-3451, for the use of the waters of Badger Creek when available with any deficiency in the available supply from Badger Creek to be made * for the PURPOSE of irrigation of 354.6 acres

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from January 3, 1986

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 8.9 cubic feet per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Badger Creek P.O.D. - 1290 feet South and 550 feet West from the Center Quarter Corner of Section 29, being within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 29, Township 3 South, Range 11 East; Badger Lake Reservoir constructed under Permit R-773 (Application R-13087) P.O.D. - 400 feet North and 800 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 16, being within the SW 1/4 **

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

- * up by appropriation from Threemile Creek, then Badger Lake Reservoir constructed under Application R-13087, Permit R-773 then Pine Hollow Reservoir constructed under Application R-45211, Permit R-5250,
- ** SW 1/4 of Section 16, Township 3 South, Range 10 East; 3-Mile Creek P.O.D. - 1530 feet South and 4580 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 11, being within the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 11, Township 4 South, Range 11 East; Pine Hollow Reservoir constructed under Permit R-5250 (Application R-45211) P.O.D. - 700 feet South and 1930 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 10, being within the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 10, Township 4 South, Range 12 East, WM, in the County of Wasco.

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 29, 1988 , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 89 . Extended to October 1, 1991

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 90 . Extended to October 1, 1991
