## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to

Jeremiah S. Boehmer of 1962 Applegate Avenue, Grants Pass, Oregon 97526, phone 476-4151, for the use of the waters of Applegate River and Applegate Reservoir constructed under Application R-57600, Permit R-7810, irrigation of 2.4 acres

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from

May 12, 1987

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed

0.03 cubic foot

per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED:

40 feet South and 1150 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 29, being within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 29, Township 36 South, Range 6 West, WM, Applegate Lake Dam is located in the S 1/2 SE 1/4 of Section 25, Township 40 South, Range 4 West, WM, both in the County of Josephine.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 36 South, Range 6 West, WM Section 29 NE 1/4 NW 1/4 2.4 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and is subject to the terms and conditions of Contract 7-07-10-W0692 between the Bureau of Reclamation and the applicant, or a satisfactory replacement, a copy of which is on file in the records of the Water Resources Director, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before \_\_\_\_\_, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before ~~October 1, 1988~~ October 29, 1988

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1990
