PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to
Hugo Stephanus Kruythoff of PO Box 1241, Grants Pass, Oregon 97526, phone 479-1632, for the use of the waters of Applegate River and Applegate Reservoir constructed under Application R-57600, Permit R-7810, a tributary of * irrigation of 2.0 acres

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from
June 4, 1987

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.025 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED:
550 feet East and 720 feet South from the Northwest Corner of Section 15, being within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 15, Township 37 South, Range 6 West, WM, Applegate Lake Dam is located in the S 1/2 SE 1/4 of Section 25, Township 40 South, Range 4 West, WM, both in the County of Josephine.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

* Rogue River,

Township 37 South, Range 6 West, WM Section 15 NE 1/4 SW 1/4 2.0 acres
Irrigation

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and is subject to the terms and conditions of Contract 7-07-10-W0690 between the Bureau of Reclamation and the applicant, or a satisfactory replacement, a copy of which is on file in the records of the Water Resources Director, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 29, 1988, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 29, 1989

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1990
