This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 69127 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

 Umpqua River, for the PURPOSE of
 irrigation of 7.5 acres

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from

June 8, 1987

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed

0.094 cubic foot

per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED:

520 feet North and 250 feet West from the South 1/4
 Corner of Section 16, being within the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 16, Township 29
 South, Range 6 West, WM, in the County of Douglas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 29 South, Range 6 West, WM Section 16 SE 1/4 SW 1/4 7.5 acres
 Irrigation

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, being further limited during the period July 15 through September 30 of each year to the irrigation of a noncommercial garden not to exceed one-half acre in area and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before _____, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before ~~October 129, 1988~~ October 1, 1989

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1990
