PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to

Highland Tree Farms, Inc., of PO Box 112, Monmouth, Oregon 97361, phone 838-1020, for the use of the waters of Little Luckimute River, a tributary of Luckimute River, irrigation of 40.0 acres

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from
June 29, 1987

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.5 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED:
2120 feet North and 520 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 31, being within the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 31, Township 8 South, Range 5 West, WM, in the County of Polk.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 8 South, Range 5 West, WM	Section 31	NE 1/4	NE 1/4	2.2 acres

		SE 1/4	NE 1/4	22.6 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 29, 1988, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1989 Extended to October 1, 1991

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1990 Extended to October 1, 1991
