PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **68801** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Bureau of Land Management of 777 N.W. Garden Valley Blvd., Roseburg, Oregon 97470, phone 672-4491, for the use of the waters of an unnamed tributary of Van Dine Creek and Tail Gate Reservoir to be constructed under* for the PURPOSE of fire control

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from July 23, 1986

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.7 cubic foot per second, being 0.69 cfs for fire control and 0.01 cfs for maintenance of the reservoir, and 0.6 acre-foot of stored water from Tail Gate Reservoir to be **

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 775 feet North and 275 feet West from the Southeast corner of Section 25, being within the SE1/4 SE1/4 of Section 25, Township 29 South, Range 6 West, W.M., in the County of Douglas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 90.
