PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 69061 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Joseph J. McAleavey of 380 Cheney Creek Road, Grants Pass, Oregon 97527, phone 479-5806, for the use of the waters of unnamed springs "A" and "B", tributaries of (A): Cheney Creek and (B): an unnamed natural pond. for the PURPOSE of Domestic use for one family, including the irrigation of a non-commercial garden not to exceed one-half acre in area from Spring "A" and maintenance of a natural pond for wildlife from Spring "B". that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from April 20, 1987 for use from Spring "A" and June 26, 1987 for use from Spring "B".

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.06 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 cfs from Spring "A" for domestic use and 0.05 from Spring "B" for maintenance of a natural pond for wildlife.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Spring "A": 725 feet North and 1120 feet West from the South Quarter Corner of Section 7; Spring "B": 50 feet North and 1950 feet West from the Southeast corner of Section 7, being within "A": SE1/4 SW1/4 and "B": SW1/4 SE1/4, both in Section 7, Township 37 South, Range 6 West, W.M., in the County of Josephine.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 37 South, Range 6 West, W.M.,	Section 7	SW1/4 SE1/4	Maintenance of pond for Wildlife
		SE1/4 SE1/4	Domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre noncommercial garden

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 30, 1988 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 89. Extended to October 1, 1991

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 90. Extended to October 1, 1991
