## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 69084 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Waverley Country Club, of 1100 SE Waverley Drive, Milwaukie, Oregon 97222, phone 654-6521, for the use of the waters of the Willamette River and reservoir to be constructed under Application R-69083, Permit\* for the PURPOSE of irrigation of 128.8 acres and maintenance of a reservoir for golf course water hazard,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from May 6, 1987

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1.612 cubic feet per second, being 1.6 cfs for irrigation and 0.012 for maintenance of reservoir for golf course water hazard.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Willamette River: 650 feet South and 25 feet East from the Southwest corner of the SW1/4 NW1/4 of Section 26, being within the NW1/4 SW1/4; Reservoir: 75 feet North and 270 feet East from the Southeast corner of the SE1/4 NW1/4 of Section 26, being within the SE1/4 NW1/4, both\*\*

The AMDUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot par second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, from direct flow and storage from reservoir to be constructed under Permit R-10884, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 30, 1988, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 89.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 90.
