PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68858 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to KLEOS Ministries, Gordon Hankins, Director, of P.O. Box 41, Klamath Falls, Oregon, phone 884–2152, for the use of the waters of the Williamson River and the Sprague River,

for the PURPOSE of irrigation of 87.35 acres and maintenance of a pond (existing quarry site) for recreation,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from April 29, 1987,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 3.18 cubic feet per second, being 0.82 cfs from Williamson River for irrigation of 32.75 acres, 1.36 cfs from Sprague River when available with any deficiency in the* The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Williamson River: 3390 feet North and 2530 feet West from the Southeast corner of Section 20, being within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 20; Sprague River: 1550 feet North and 1250 feet West from the Southeast corner of Section 3, being within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 3,**

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

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The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to $\underline{1/40}$ of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $\underline{3.0}$ acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 24, 1988, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 89, $\frac{2\times 7}{10^{-1}-9}$ o

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 $\,$ 90 .
