## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 69153 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Karl H. Moll of 16084 South Forsythe Road, Oregon City, Oregon 97045, phone 655-1009, for the use of the waters of Balm Creek and an unnamed spring, tributaries of the John Day River, for the PURPOSE of irrigation of 10.0 acres and domestic use for two families,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from June 29, 1987

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.26 cubic foot per second, being 0.25 cfs from Balm Creek for irrigation and 0.01 cfs from the spring for domestic use,

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Balm Creek: 70 feet South and 300 feet West from the Southeast corner of Section 24, being within the NE1/4 NE1/4 of Section 25, Township 8 South, Range 25 East W.M.; spring: 700 feet North and 900 feet East from the Southeast corner of Section 24, being within the SW1/4 SW1/4 of Section 19, Township 8 South, Range 26 East, W.M., in the County of Wheeler.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 8 South, Range 25 East, W.M., Section 24	SW1/4 SE1/4	3.3 acres and domestic
	SE1/4 SE1/4	2.7 acres
Section 25	NW1/4 NE1/4	4.0 acres and domestic

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/40 cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 24, 1988, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 89 .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 90 .
