PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 69174 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Elwin H. Price of 1199 Spooner Ridge Lane, Oakland, Oregon, 97462, phone 459-4440, for the use of the waters of an unnamed stream, a tributary of Yellow Creek, for the PURPOSE of Domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn or noncommercial garden,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from June 30, 1987,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 750 feet South and 800 feet West from the Northeast corner of Section 13, being within the NE1/4 NE1/4 of Section 13, Township 24 South, Range 7 West, W.M., in the County of Douglas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 24 South, Range 7 West, W.M., Section 13 NW1/4 NE1/4 Domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn or noncommercial garden

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 24, 1988, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 89 .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 90 .
