This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 69263 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Kirpal Light Satsang, by Christopher Meek, of 7637 Tyee Road, Umpqua, Oregon, 97486, phone 459-1181, for the use of the waters of an unnamed stream and Rock Creek, a tributary of the Umpqua River,

irrigation of 56.5 acres and maintenance of a fire protection for the PURPOSE of system,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from

September 1, 1987,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.363 cubic foot per second, being 0.24 cfs from the unnamed stream for irrigation of 34.5 acres, 0.25 cfs from Rock Creek for irrigation of 22.0 acres and 0.013 cfs* The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Rock Creek: 1440 feet North and 1880 feet West from the Southeast corner of Section 9; unnamed stream: 2450 feet South and 1350 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 10, being withing (Rock Creek) NW1/4 SE1/4 of Section 9; unnamed stream: SW1/4 NE1/4 of Section 10. both in Township 25 South, Range 7 West, W.M., in the County of Douglas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 25 South, Range 7 West, W.M., Section 9

NW1/4 SE1/4 1.0 acre

SW1/4 SE1/4 16.0 acres

SE1/4 SE1/4 5.0 acres

* from the unnamed stream for maintenance of the fire protection system.

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 24, 1988 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 87. Extended to October 1, 1990

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 90. Extended to October 1, 1991 16-1-92,10-1-95
