This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68962 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Johan Mehlum of P.O. Box 131, Florence, Oregon 97439, phone 997-3486 (business), for the use of the waters of Woahink Lake,

for the PURPOSE of

Domestic use for one family.

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from May 11 1987,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.005 cubic foot per second.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 900 feet South and 1430 feet West from the Center of Section 23, being within the NW1/4 SW1/4 of Section 23, Township 19 South, Range 12 West, W.M., in the County of Lane.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 19 South, Range 12 West, W.M., Section 23 NE1/4 SW1/4 Domestic use for one family

Actual construction work shall begin on or before December 9, 1988, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 90.
