## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 69142 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Richard G. Fischer of 9383 John Day Drive, Gold Hill, Oregon 97525, phone 855-7077, for the use of the waters of the Rogue River and Lost Creek Reservoir constructed under Application R-56223, Permit R-8142, for the PURPOSE of irrigation of 6.0 acres,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from June 22, 1987,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.075 cubic foot per second.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 183 feet South and 15 feet West from the Northwest corner of Government Lot 1 of Section 12, being within the NE1/4 NW1/4 of Section 12, Township 36 South, Range 3 West, W.M.; Lost Creek Dam is located in the SW1/4 NW1/4 and W1/2 of Section 26, Township 33 South, Range 1 East, W.M., both in the County of Jackson.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows: Township 36 South, Range 3 West, W.M., Section 12 NE1/4 NW1/4 6.0 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to a diversion of not to exceed  $\frac{1}{80}$  of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage storage from Lost Creek Reservoir constructed under Permit R-8142, and is subject to the terms and condition of Contract 7-07-10-W0693 between the Bureau of Reclamation and the applicant, or a satisfactory replacement, a copy of which is on file in the records of the Water Resources Director, and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before December 9, 1988, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 89.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 90.
