PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 69186 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to William A. Barton of P.O. Box 1337, Gold Beach, Oregon 97491, phone 247-2386, for the use of the waters of four unnamed streams (A), (B), (C) and (D and E) and a spring (F), tributaries of the Rogue River, for the PURPOSE of stockwater, irrigation of 4.0 acres and domestic use for one family,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from July 8, 1987,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 32.65 gallons per minute, being 2.0 gallons per minute from each of streams (A), (B), (C) and (F) for stockwater, 22.4 gpm from stream (E) for irrigation and 2.25 gpm from*

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Diversion (A): 650 feet South and 1339 feet East; Diversion (B): 1883 feet South and 1125 feet East; Diversion (C): 2126 feet South and 899 feet East; Diversion (D): 1680 feet South and 687 feet East; Diversion (E): 1888 feet South and 689 feet East; Diversion (F): 1980 feet South and 482 feet East, all from the the North Quarter Corner of Section 20, being**

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows: Township 36 South, Range 14 West, W.M., Section 20 NE1/4 NE1/4 Stockwater

MEIVA NEIVA STOCKWATE

SW1/4 NE1/4 Domestic use,

Stockwater and

3.0 acres

SE1/4 NW1/4 1.0 acre

* spring (F) for domestic use.

** within (A) NE1/4 NE1/4, (B), (C), (D), (E) and (F) SW1/4 NE1/4 of Section 20, Township 36 South, Range 14 West, W.M., in the County of Curry.

The AMDUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to a diversion of not to exceed $\frac{1/80}{2.5}$ of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $\frac{2.5}{2.5}$ acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before December 9, 1988, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19, 89.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 90.
