PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 69219 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Delta Sand and Gravel Company of 999 Division Avenue, Eugene, Oregon 97404, phone 688-2233, for the use of the waters of the Willamette River, a tributary of the Columbia River, for the PURPOSE of washing of sand and gravel,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from August 4, 1987,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 14.0 cubic feet per second.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 402 feet South and 626 feet East from the Northwest corner of Section 18, being within the NW1/4 NW1/4 of Section 18, Township 17 South, Range 3 West, W.M., in the County of Lane.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 17 South, Range 3 West, W.M., Section 18 NW1/4 NW1/4 Washing of sand and gravel

This permit is issued subject to the maintenance and use of adequate treatment facilities to remove the sediment before returning the water to the stream.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before December 9, 1988, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 89.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 90.
