## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 69230 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Thomas G. Watts of 632 Big Bend Road, Rosebur phone 672-6947, for the use of the waters of the Umpqua River, Thomas G. Watts of 632 Big Bend Road, Roseburg, Oregon 97470,

for the PURPOSE of

irrigation of 12.0 acres.

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from

August 11, 1987,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed foot per second. 0.15 cubic

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 200 feet North and 155 feet west from the Guarter Corner of Section 19, being within the SE1/4 SW1/4 of Section 19, 200 feet North and 155 feet West from the South Township 26 South, Range 6 West, W.M., in the County of Douglas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 26 South, Range 6 West, W.M., Section 19 SE1/4 SW1/4 1.5 acres SW1/4 SE1/4 10.0 acres

Section 30 NW1/4 NE1/4 0.5 acre

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before December 9, 1988, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 89.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 90.
