## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 69261 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following

This permit is issued to Maxine D. Pfeiffer of 6172 Tyee Road, Umpqua, Oregon 97486, phone 459-5412, for the use of the waters of the Umpqua River,

for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one—half acre of lawn or noncommercial garden,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from September 1, 1987,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 4.0 gallons per minute.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 690 feet North and 850 feet East from the Center of Section 16, being within the SW1/4 NE1/4 of Section 16, Township 25 South, Range 7 West, W.M., in the County of Douglas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 25 South, Range 7 West, W.M., Section 16 SW1/4 NE1/4 Domestic use

Domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one—half acre lawn or noncommercial garden.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before December 31, 1988, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 89

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19  $\,$  90 .
