PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **69220** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **Peter W. Schoeningh, Jr.** of P.O. Box 91 (Anthony Lake Road), Haines, Oregon 97833, phone 856-3777, for the use of the waters of Warm Springs Creek (Hot Creek), a tributary of the Powder River, for the PURPOSE of supplemental irrigation of 44.0 acres,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **August 6, 1987,**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **1.1 cubic feet per second.**

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: **540 feet North and 20 feet East from the Southwest corner of Section 6 being within the SW1/4 SW1/4 of Section 6, Township 7 South, Range 39 East, W.M., in the County of Baker.**

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 7 South, Range 39 East, W.M., Section 6	SW1/4 SW1/4	14.0 acres
	SE1/4 SW1/4	18.0
	SW1/4 SE1/4	12.0

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.5 acre-feet per acre during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **January 21, 1989**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before **October 1, 19 89.**

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before **October 1, 19 90.**
