PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68406 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Maple Headquarters, N.W. of Route 2, Box 389, Forest Grove, Oregon 97116, phone 359-4453, for the use of the waters of an unnamed tributary of East Fork Dairy Creek and Roy Farm Pond Reservoir, to be constructed under\* for the PURPOSE of nursery operations, including containerized nursery stock and greenhouses.

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from June 24, 1985, for 1.31 cfs and July 19, 1985, for 1.31 cfs.

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 2.62 cubic feet per second, being 2.54 cfs for containerized nursery stock on 101.7 acres+

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 795 feet South and 2663 feet West from the Northeast corner of Section 16, being within the NE1/4 NW1/4 of Section 16, Township 1 North, Range 3 West, W.M., in the County of Washington.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

+ and 0.08 cfs for greenhouse use on 3.4 acres, provided that water shall not be appropriated from direct flow during the period from July 31 through September 15 of each year,

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 29, 1989, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 89

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 90
