## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **69183** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **Michael B. Banks and Marianne Alderson** of Route 1, Box 23, Milton-Freewater, Oregon 97862, phone 938-7321, for the use of the waters of Couse Creek, a tributary of the Walla Walla River, for the PURPOSE of **irrigation of 22.0 acres,**

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **September 18, 1987,**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **115.0 gallons per minute.**

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: (1) 110 feet South and 625 feet East; (2) 640 feet South and 580 feet East, both from the Northwest corner of the SW1/4 of Section 19; (3) 495 feet North and 530 feet East from the Southwest corner of the NW 1/4 of Section 19, being within (1) NW1/4 SW1/4, (2) NW1/4 SW1/4 and (3) SW1/4 NW1/4, all in Section 19, Township 5 North, Range 36 East, in the County\*

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 5 North, Range 36 East, W.M., Section 19	SW1/4 NW1/4	7.6 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **February 28, 1989** and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 **89.**

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 **90.**
