## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 69232 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Carl J. Stokes of 1700 Pine Gate Way, White City, Oregon 97503, phone 826-5996, for the use of the waters of Lost Creek Reservoir constructed under Application R-56223, Permit R-8142, for the PURPOSE of supplemental irrigation of 24.0 acres,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from August 12, 1987,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 24.0 acre-feet stored water only.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Lost Creek Dam: SW1/4 NW1/4 and W1/2 SW1/4 of Section 26, Township 33 South, Range 1 East, W.M.; Rediversion from Rogue River: 326 feet North and 1720 feet East from the Southwest corner of Section 29, being within the SE1/4 SW1/4 of Section 29, Township 35 South, Range 1 West, W.M., all in the County of Jackson.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 35 South, Range 1 West, W.M., Section 29	SW1/4 SW1/4	18.8 acres
	SE1/4 SW1/4	5.2 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and is subject to the terms and conditions of Contract 7-07-10-W0691 between the Bureau of Reclamation and the applicant, or a satisfactory replacement, a copy of which is on file in the records of the Water Resources Department, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 28, 1989 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 89.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 90.
