PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 69426 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to John R. Kurka of HC 84, Box 6B82, Myrtle Point, Oregon 97458, phone 888-4708, for the use of the waters of a spring and South Fork Coquille River, a tributary of the Coquille River, for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family and irrigation of 11.6 acres,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from October 23, 1987,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.155 cubic foot per second, being 0.005 from the spring for domestic use and 0.15 from South Fork Coquille River for irrigation.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Spring: 1650 feet South and 725 feet West; River: 710 feet North and 10 feet East, both from the Southwest corner of Section 32, Township 29 South, Range 12 West, being within (spring): SE1/4 NE1/4 of Section 6, Township 30 South, Range 12 West, W.M., (River): SW1/4 SW1/4 of Section 32, Township 29 South, Range 12 West, W.M., in the County of Jackson.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 29 South, Range 12 West, W.M., Section 32	SW1/4 SW1/4	10.25 acres
Township 30 South, Range 12 West, W.M., Section 5	NW1/4 NW1/4	1.35 acres
	NW1/4 NW1/4	Domestic use for one family.

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to $\frac{1}{80}$ of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 28, 1989, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 89.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 90.
