PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 69308 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Loren L. Ray of 416 Northeast Baker Drive, Grants Pass, Oregon 97526, phone 476-8949, for the use of the waters of an unnamed stream, a tributary of Quail Creek,

for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family and irrigation of 3.0 acres,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from September 18, 1987, for 0.01 cubic foot per second and January 19, 1988, for 0.035 cfs,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.045 cubic foot per second, being 0.005 cfs for domestic use and 0.04 cfs for irrigation.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 830 feet North and 620 feet East from the Southwest corner of the NW1/4 NW1/4 of Section 7, being within the NW1/4 NW1/4 of Section 7, Township 33 South, Range 9 West, W.M., in the County of Curry.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 33 South, Range 10 West, W.M., Section 12 SE1/4 NE1/4 D

Domestic use for one family and 3.0 acres irrigation

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 28, 1989, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19, 89.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 90.
