PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 69313 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

Edward Price, Trustee, of P.O. Box 2427, White City, Oregon This permit is issued to 97503, phone 826-2642, for the use of the waters of the Rogue River, a tributary of the Pacific Ocean,

domestic use for one family and irrigation of not to exceed 0.5 for the PURPOSE of acre lawn or garden,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from September 23, 1987,

0.011 and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed cubic foot per second, being 0.005 cfs for domestic use and 0.006 cfs for irrigation.

100 feet North and 240 feet West from the The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Center quarter-corner of Section 3, being within the SE1/4 NW1/4 of Section 3, Township 34 South, Range 1 West, W.M., in the County of Jackson.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 34 South, Range 1 West, W.M., Section 3 SE1/4 NW1/4 Domestic use for NE1/4 SW1/4 one family and irrigation of 0.5 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 28, 1989 , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 89.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 90.
