PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 69396 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Robert L. and Carol M. Bowen of P.O. Box 1797, Florence, Oregon 97439, phone 997-7285, for the use of the waters of the Cleawox Lake,

for the PURPOSE of Domestic use for one family,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from October 7, 1987,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.005 cubic foot per second.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1056 feet North and 2813 feet West from the Southeast corner of Section 3, being within the SW1/4 SE1/4 of Section 3, Township 19 South, Range 12 West, W.M., in the County of Lane.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 19 South, Range 12 West, W.M., Section 3 SW1/4 SE1/4 Domestic use
for one family

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 28, 1989, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 89.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 90.
