PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 69051 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to U.S.D.A. Forest Service, N.F.J.D. Ranger District of P.O. Box 158, Ukiah, Oregon 97880, phone 427-3231, for use of the waters of Meadow Creek, a tributary of the Grande Ronde River,

for the PURPOSE of for compaction on excavation and aggregate and for dust abatement on timber sale roads,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from April 6, 1987,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 300 gallons per minute.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1214 feet North and 20 feet West from the Southeast corner of Section 34, being within the SE1/4 SE1/4 of Section 34, Township 3 South, Range 35 East, W.M., in the County of Union.
