PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 69279 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to George D. and Claire T. Rives of 35900 N.E. Willsonville Road, Newberg, Oregon 97132, phone 625-7367, for the use of the waters of an unnamed swale, the Willamette River and an unnamed reservoir to be constructed under* for the PURPOSE of irrigation of 3.4 acres and maintenance of a reservoir for recreation,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from September 3, 1987,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 30.0 gallons per minute, being 19.0 gpm from the Willamette River for irrigation and 30.0 gpm from the unnamed swale with any deficiency in the available supply of**

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Willamette River: 1950 feet South and 600 feet West; swale and reservoir: 1760 feet South and 620 feet West, both from the Northeast corner of Section 1, both being within the SE1/4 NE1/4 of Section 1, Township 4 South, Range 2 West, W.M., in the County of Yamhill.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 4 South, Range 2 West, W.M., Section 1 SE1/4 NE1/4 3.4 acres irrigation and recreation

** water from the swale to be made up by appropriation from the Willamette River for maintaining the reservoir for recreation.

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 30, 1989, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 89.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 90.
