## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **69415** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **Donald L. Bult** of P.O. Box 112, Mehama, Oregon 97384-0112, phone 859-2761, for the use of the waters of an unnamed stream and Bult Reservoirs #1, #2, #3 and #4 to be constructed under Application R-69414, Permit R-10898, for the PURPOSE of **maintenance of the four reservoirs for fish culture,**

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **October 19, 1987,**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **0.02** cubic foot per second.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: #1: 390 feet South and 1950 feet West; #2: 240 feet South and 1940 feet West; #3: 30 feet South and 1930 feet West; #4: 50 feet North and 1930 feet West, all from the Northeast corner of Section 18, being within: #1, #2 and #3: NW1/4 NE1/4 of Section 18; #4: SW1/4 SE1/4 of Section 7, all in Township 9 South, Range 2 East, W.M., in the County of Marion.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 9 South, Range 2 East, W.M., Section 7 SW1/4 SE1/4 Fish culture  
Section 18 NW1/4 NE1/4

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **March 30, 1989**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before **October 1, 19 89.**

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before **October 1, 19 90.**
