## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 69473 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Donald E. and Laurie M. Bowen of 38694 Luckiamute Road, Philomath, Oregon 97370, phone 929-2890, for the use of the waters of Luckiamute River, a tributary of Willamette River, for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family and irrigation of 4.0 acres,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from November 20, 1987,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.055 cubic foot per second, being 0.005 cfs for domestic use and 0.05 cfs for irrigation.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 2140 feet South and 2525 feet West from the Northwest corner of Section 19, being within the SE1/4 NW1/4 of Section 19, Township 10 South, Range 6 West, W.M., in the County of Benton.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 10 South, Range 6 West, W.M., Section 19 SE1/4 NW1/4 Domestic use for one family and irrigation of 4.0 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 30, 1989, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1989. Extended to October 1, 1991

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1990. Extended to October 1, 1991
