PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 69024 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to John F. Walchli of Route 3, Box 3342, Hermiston, Oregon 97838,
phone 567-5842, for the use of the waters of an unnamed stream and Walchli
 Reservoir constructed under Permits R-6575 and R-8362,
 for the PURPOSE of irrigation of 38.0 acres,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from March 9, 1987,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.95 cubic
foot per second.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Unnamed stream: 1040 feet North and 1540 feet
West; Reservoir: 1380 feet North and 650 feet West, both from the East 1/4
corner of Section 4, being within (stream): SW1/4 NE1/4, (Reservoir): NE1/4 NE1/4,
both in Section 4, Township 4 North, Range 29 East, W.M., in the County of Umatilla.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 4 North, Range 29 East, W.M., Section 8 SE1/4 SE1/4 38.0 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from Walchi Reservoir constructed under Permits R-6575 and R-8362, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 16, 1989, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 90.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 91.
