## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 69131 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to C. M. Hubbard, Jr. of 27511 West Ingram Island Road, Monroe, Oregon 97456, phone 847-5285, for the use of the waters of an unnamed lake, a tributary of the Long Tom River, for the PURPOSE of irrigation of 232.7 acres,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from June 11, 1987,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 2.9 cubic feet per second.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1827.5 feet North and 899.5 feet East from the Southwest corner of Section 35, being within the NW1/4 SW1/4 of Section 35, Township 13 South, Range 5 West, W.M., in the County of Benton.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 16, 1989, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 90.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 91.
