PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 69429 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Owen L. and Marylyn R. Gossett of 11630 Agate Road, Eagle Point, Oregon 97524, phone 826-4447, for the use of the waters of the Roque River,

for the PURPOSE of Domestic use for one family including the irrigation of lawn or noncommercial garden not to exceed one-half acre in area,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from October 27, 1987,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed foot per second,

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 400 feet South and 140 feet East from the Northwest corner of Section 20, being within the NW1/4 NW1/4 of Section 20, Township 32 South, Range 3 East, W.M., in the County of Jackson.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 32 South, Range 3 East, W.M., Section 20 NW1/4 NW1/4

Domestic use for one family including the irrigation of lawn or noncommercial garden not to exceed one-half acre in area.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 16, 1989, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19, 90. Extended to October 1, 1991

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 91.
