PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **69399** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **International Paper Company, Kellogg Forest Tree Nursery of 1940 Madison Road, Oakland, Oregon 97462, phone 459-5903, for the use of the waters of the Umpqua River and Galesville Reservoir constructed under*** for the PURPOSE of **commercial nursery use to include irrigation during the period October 1 through March 31 of each year when water can be put to beneficial use for immediate crop growth or to raise the soil moisture content to be utilized**** that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **October 9, 1987**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **10.9 cubic feet per second.**

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: **(1): 60 feet North and 410 feet West from the Southeast corner of Section 30; (2): 1980 feet North and 670 feet West from the Northeast corner of DLC 42, being within (1): SE1/4 SE1/4 of Section 30; (2): NW1/4 SW1/4 of Section 20, both in Township 23 South, Range 7 West, W.M.;*****

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

*** Galesville Reservoir dam is located within the SW1/4 NE1/4 of Section 28, Township 31 South, Range 4 West, W.M., all being in the County of Douglas.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **June 23, 1989** , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 **90** .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 **91** .
