PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 69539 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Thomas A. and Wilma G. Rosenthal of 1080 Ferry Road, Grants Pass, Oregon 97526, phone 476-7956, for the use of the waters of the Rogue River,

for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family including the irrigation of a noncommercial garden not to exceed one-half acre in area,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from March 1, 1988,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 945 feet South and 1530 feet West from the East Quarter corner of Section 2, being within the NW1/4 SE1/4 of Section 2, Township 36 South, Range 7 West, W.M., in the County of Josephine.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 36 South, Range 7 West, W.M., Section 2 SE1/4 NE1/4 Domestic use for one family including the irrigation of noncommercial garden not to exceed one-half acre in area.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 23, 1989, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 90 .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 91 .
