PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 69558 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Mildred Weaver of 33982 Ophir Road, Gold Beach, Oregon 97444, phone 247-6320, for the use of the waters of a spring, a tributary of Weaver Creek,

for the PURPOSE of

domestic use for two families,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from March 14, 1988,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **0.01 cubic foot per second.**

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 160 feet South and 797 feet West from the Southeast corner of the NE1/4 SE1/4 of Section 19, being within the SE1/4 SE1/4 of Section 19, Township 35 South, Range 14 West, W.M., in the County of Curry.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 35 South, Range 14 West, W.M., Section 19 NE1/4 SE1/4 Domestic use for two families.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 23, 1989, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19, 90.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 91.
