### PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

are hereby issued a permit to use waters from SPRING CREEK, a tributary of JENNY CREEK for the purpose of AQUACULTURE to include hatching and rearing of trout, salmon, crawfish and fresh water lobsters. This permit is issued under Application 69052 with a date of priority of APRIL 8, 1987. This permit is limited to not more than 8.9 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

(point 1) SE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 3, T 41 S, R 04 E, WM;  
1650 FEET SOUTH & 2060 FEET EAST FROM NW CORNER, SECTION 3.

(point 2) SW 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 3, T 41 S, R 04 E, WM;  
2312 FEET SOUTH & 930 FEET EAST FROM NW CORNER, SECTION 3.

(point 3) SW 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 3, T 41 S, R 04 E, WM;  
2300 FEET SOUTH & 1130 FEET EAST FROM NW CORNER, SECTION 3.

The use of water allowed under this permit shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under this permit is as follows:

1/4 1/4	SECTION	TOWNSHIP	RANGE, WM
SE NW	3	41 S	04 E

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 12, 1989, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1990. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1991. This permit is for the beneficial use of water. \*

THE APPLICATION WAS REVIEWED AND CONSIDERED BY THE WATER RESOURCES COMMISSION ON APRIL 1, 1988.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan. It is possible that the land use you propose may not be allowed if it is not in keeping with the goals and the acknowledged plan. Your city or county planning agency can advise you about the land-use plan in your area.
