is hereby issued a permit to use waters from the JOHN DAY RIVER, A TRIBUTARY OF COLUMBIA RIVER for IRRIGATION OF 3.47 ACRES. This permit to the use of these waters has been issued under Application 69162 with a date of priority of JUNE 29, 1987.

This permit is limited to an amount of water that may be benifically used not to exceed 0.06 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 36, T 08 S, R 24 E, WM; 1725 FEET SOUTH & 1625 FEET WEST FROM NE CORNER, SECTION 36.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, BEING FURTHER LIMITED TO: 0.2 ACRE-FOOT PER ACRE IRRIGATED DURING MAY; 0.6 ACRE-FOOT PER ACRE IRRIGATED DURING JUNE; 0.9 ACRE-FOOT PER ACRE IRRIGATED DURING JULY; 0.7 ACRE-FOOT PER ACRE IRRIGATED DURING AUGUST; 0.1 ACRE-FOOT PER ACRE IRRIGATED DURING SEPTEMBER

The use of water allowed under this permit shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the permit is as follows:

When in the judgement of the watermaster it becomes necessary to measure and keep a record of the amount of water being diverted, the right allowed herein shall be subject to the installation and maintenance of an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water.

THE APPLICATION WAS REVIEWED AND CONSIDERED BY THE WATER RESOURCES COMMISSION ON APRIL 1, 1988.

The use of water under this permit is contingent upon continuing compliance with the conditions of any required discharge permit for water quality control held by the water right permittee.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 12, 1989 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1990. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1991.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water. By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan. It is possible that the land use you propose may not be allowed if it is not in keeping with the goals and the acknowledged plan. Your city or county planning agency can advise you about the land-use plan in your area.

This right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
