PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

is hereby issued a permit to use waters from the UMPQUA RIVER, a tributary of the PACIFIC OCEAN for IRRIGATION of 5.93 acres. The permit is issued under Application 69442 with a date of priority of OCTOBER 30, 1987. This permit is limited to not more than 0.074 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 24, T 26 S, R 07 W, WM;
1300 FEET NORTH & 750 FEET WEST FROM SE CORNER, SECTION 24

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eighteenth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use of water allowed under this permit shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the permit is as follows:

Total: 5.93 acres.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 12, 1989 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1990. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1991.
