is hereby issued a permit to use the waters of MISSION CREEK, a tributary of the WILLAMETTE RIVER for maintaining Zorn Farms Reservoir to be constructed under Application R-69447, Permit 10903 for wetland condition for wildlife habitat. This permit is issued under Application 69448 with a date of priority of NOVEMBER 3, 1987. This permit is limited to not more than 0.020 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 10, T 04 S, R 02 W, WM; 1436.87 FEET NORTH & 2789.6 FEET WEST FROM COUNTY MONUMENT AT THE COMMON DLC CORNER: SE CORNER OF THE JOSEPH DESPARD CLAIM NO. 41 AND THE SW CORNER OF THE ROBERT ADY CLAIM NO. 42.

The use of water allowed under this permit shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the permit, and to which such permit is appurtenant, is as follows:

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 12, 1989 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1990. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1991.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water. By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan. It is possible that the land use you propose may not be allowed if it is not in keeping with the goals and the acknowledged plan. Your city or county planning agency can advise you about the land-use plan in your area.
