PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

are hereby issued a permit to use the waters from the NORTH FORK ROGUE RIVER, A TRIBUTARY TO THE ROGUE RIVER for DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY AND IRRIGATION OF 3.0 ACRES. This permit to the use of these waters has been issued under Application 69490 with a date of priority of NOVEMBER 25, 1987.

This permit is limited to not more than 0.043 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, BEING 0.005 CFS FOR DOMESTIC AND 0.038 CFS FOR IRRIGATION or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 29, T 32 S, R 03 E, WM;
590 FEET SOUTH & 100 FEET EAST FROM W1/4 CORNER, SECTION 29.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The permit shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the permit is as follows:

Total: 3.00 acres.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 12, 1989, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1990. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1991. This permit is for the beneficial use of water.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan. It is possible that the land use you propose may not be allowed if it is not in keeping with the goals and the acknowledged plan. Your city or county planning agency can advise you about the land-use plan in your area.

This right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
