This permit is limited to not more than 0.005 cubic foot per second or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion. The diversion and use of water is further limited to the period of November 1 through March 31 of each year.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 10, T 18 S, R 10 E, WM; 340 FEET SOUTH & 900 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER, SECTION 10.

The use of water allowed under this permit shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The place of use is as follows:

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 18, 1989, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1990. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1991.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water. By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan. It is possible that the land use you propose may not be allowed if it is not in keeping with the goals and the acknowledged plan. Your city or county planning agency can advise you about the land-use plan in your area.
