is hereby issued a permit to use waters from an UNNAMED STREAM, A TRIBUTARY of AMAZON CREEK for the purpose of IRRIGATION OF 0.73 ACRE and to maintain a fish pond. This permit has been issued under Application 69504 with a date of priority of November 27, 1987.

This permit is limited to an amount of water that may be beneficially used not to exceed 6.0 gallons per minute being 4.0 gpm for irrigation and 2.0 gpm for maintaining the fish pond or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 16, T 18 S, R 3 W, WM; 561.9 FEET SOUTH & 424.4 FEET EAST FROM THE WEST 1/4 CORNER, SECTION 16.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use of water allowed under this permit shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The place of use is as follows:

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 18, 1989, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1990. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1991.

It is possible that the land use you propose may not be allowed if it is not in keeping with the goals and the acknowledged plan.
